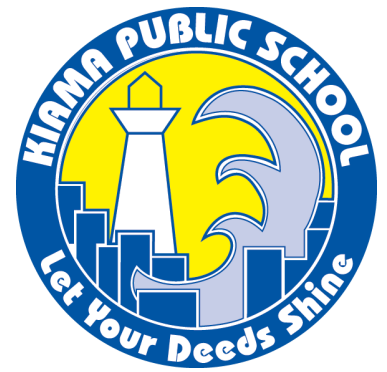


KPS GOOGLE CLASSROOM STUDENT EXPECTATIONS



Welcome to our Google Classroom! Our online classroom is an extension of our physical classrooms and our school values are as important online as they are face-to-face. Please review these with your families so you are aware of the teachers' expectations in this online space.

This is a space for students to engage with their teachers and peers.

Parents and carers are asked not to use this platform to contact teachers. Please contact teachers via the school email, classroom teacher's email (or Dojo/Seesaw) or a phone call. Messages will be forwarded onto relevant staff members to assist with enquiries.

Teachers will be online to assist and answer questions in the Google Classroom in normal school hours, from 8:45am to 3:15pm. We understand that some students will be engaging with the Google Classroom outside of these hours and we will endeavour to reply within 24 hours.

RESPECT

Using respectful language to support peers in problem solving

Writing in full sentences, using appropriate punctuation to express your ideas

Using 'emojis' only to help express your feelings and show tone in your voice

Using 'Classroom Playground' to connect with peers in respectful ways

Helping and supporting others if they post a question in the Google Classroom

Treating others online exactly the same as you would face-to-face

RESPONSIBILITY

Login on school days in YOUR ACCOUNT and complete the roll daily

Listen to other people's questions and ideas

Complete set tasks to the best of your ability independently (no need to write 'done')

Submit 'assignments' when they are completed

Check for and reflect on feedback from teachers so you can grow as a learner

Use 'Class Comments' section to ask questions about specific tasks

Ask for help from someone at home or your teachers!

Take your time to complete learning tasks that are assigned to you

Provide quality evidence of learning, not just quantity!

RESILIENCE

Waiting patiently for a teacher to reply in Google Classroom

Choosing another task to complete if waiting for support

Staying calm and positive when faced with a challenging learning task online

Sticking at learning new skills like uploading your assignments!

Trying a new strategy (e.g. working on paper instead of digital!)
