

You CAN use your mobile phone while driving if:

- It is secured in a commercially manufactured and designed mounting which is fixed to the vehicle and does not obscure the driver's view of the road, or
- It can be operated by the driver without touching any part of the phone, for example through the use of Bluetooth technology or voice activation.

While driving, you CANNOT have a mobile phone:

- Rest on any other part of the driver's body
- Be used for text messaging, video messaging, emailing or similar
- Be held in the driver's hand other than to pass it to a passenger
- Be used while stopped at traffic lights.





Learner and P P1 drivers are not permitted to use any function of a phone while operating a vehicle.
