ONGOING:

- <u>Buddy Bench</u> Year 5 leading the way each break. Seems to be working well as a temp measure so we may make a more permanent solution.
- Outdoor Kitchen very slow as we are dependent on funding cheaply. May have to resign ourselves to stage development as we have a plan but little progress as yet. Need to have it managed as Steve has too much to do.
- **BYOT** being reviewed and possibly expanded in 2015.
- <u>Science Room</u> plan established just trying to find time.
 Units are ready and now purchasing equipment request P&C funds for special equipment eg. flat screen interactive TV \$6K and science equipment.
- **Ethics** not enough trained teachers for program to meet our needs 2015 Kindergarten.
- Beautification of Quad A (Infants) like to paint it and brighten it up if considered a priority for P&C as it may require a day of action. No progress.
- <u>L3</u> will require extra funding for Year 1 if we want to continue down that path. School doesn't have extra funding so we may need to ask for assistance.
